Silver plated mechanism - waterproof pads - automatic G ring key - high D & E key - E-F# trill - automatic whisper key mechanism in connection with low E key, can also be handled on the wing joint - whisper key lock for left thumb - 5 lined finger holes and 1 lined tone hole extending into bore - wing joint bore and small side of the boot joint rubber lined - 9 rollers: 1 on F key, 1 on F# key little finger right hand, 1 on G# key little finger right hand, 1 on B flat key right thumb, 2 on low E key right thumb, 1 on F# key for thumb, 1 on C#, 1 on D# key on long joint - built of aged curly mountain maple - complete with 2 bocals - deluxe American case - double lined zippered case cover - swabs and reed case

Instrument used in both orchestral and chamber music performances from June, 1988 through April, 2006. It has been serviced exclusively by Keith Bowen.

The case also contains a leather seat strap, 3-reed box, folding reed knife, reed-making mandrel, reed reamer, cutting block, 2 swabs, 2 hand crutches and 2 plaques. \$19,000.

Pre-war Heckel bocal, CC, 3, in excellent condition, with the words, "Heckel Biebrich", running along the top of the bocal, beginning 8.8 cm from the end. On the right side of the bocal, directly below "Heckel Biebrich" are "C C 3". On the bottom of the bocal, directly below the foregoing, is printed "Wz.ges.geschützt Made in Germany". (The last 4 letters of the third German word are not completely clear and the last letter appears to be part of a "t", but I think I've read it correctly - the word "geschützt" means protected or armored.) \$1200
